Shalom, chaveirim - hello, friends -

Everyone I know is exhausted. Exhausted from sleepless nights and constant scrolling through the news from Israel. Exhausted from the reality of what Israel faces - and quite frankly, the Jewish people.

We just exited the first 30 days (sheloshim), which is the initial period of mourning for immediate loved ones. As stories become clearer and realities sink in deeper, Israelis - from right and left - are ever more committed to eliminating Hamas' control over the Gaza Strip.

Fighting from the outside, we know very well and Israel is experiencing it in ways it has not known since 1948. Nonetheless, much as Micah Goodman (a leading Israeli thinker) predicted by October 13th, the world opinion has shifted against Israel as it fights for its existence. Whereas Israel was on the cusp of a regional alliance with Saudi Arabia, Hamas took seize of the stage by reinserting the elimination of Israel via the Palestinian cause into center stage. I am amazed how the leader of Hamas, who sits in his comfortable surroundings in Qatar, has unabashedly declared that it does not matter how many Palestinian lives are lost in the battle against Israel. Hamas operates to destroy Israel - not to lift up Palestinian lives and create a workable two state solution.

For Hamas, the larger goals are to eliminate Israel and to draw the United States into a war with Iran, which is why the U.S. has two fleets in the eastern Mediterranean.

And at the same time, there are those in our Jewish world who have sided with Hamas - often misguided and simply following a line of "Free Palestine" - and in so doing are calling for genocide against Israel and subsequently, the Jewish people. "Free Palestine" seeks the removal of Jews from the river to the sea. This current battle, which finds its greatest front outside of Israel, on college campuses has created a dangerous and intimidating environment for our Jewish children and grandchildren.

In response, the <u>Melton School</u>, which is a world-class and world-recognized center of Jewish learning, is offering a "Parent empowerment Initiative" to help parents and grandparents find the language and understanding for this moment, particularly with family members. While we will not change the outcome of the war, come join me, Mayor Pete Bass, Pastor Justin Gailey of Living Stones Church and other friends for a **RAISING OF THE ISRAELI FLAG outside New Milford Town Hall: MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13TH AT 1:00 PM.** There are those who seek the downfall of Israel. It is true. But there are those who are our allies, our friends, our supporters, and our fellow "Lovers of Israel." May we feel their love and remember we are not alone!!
